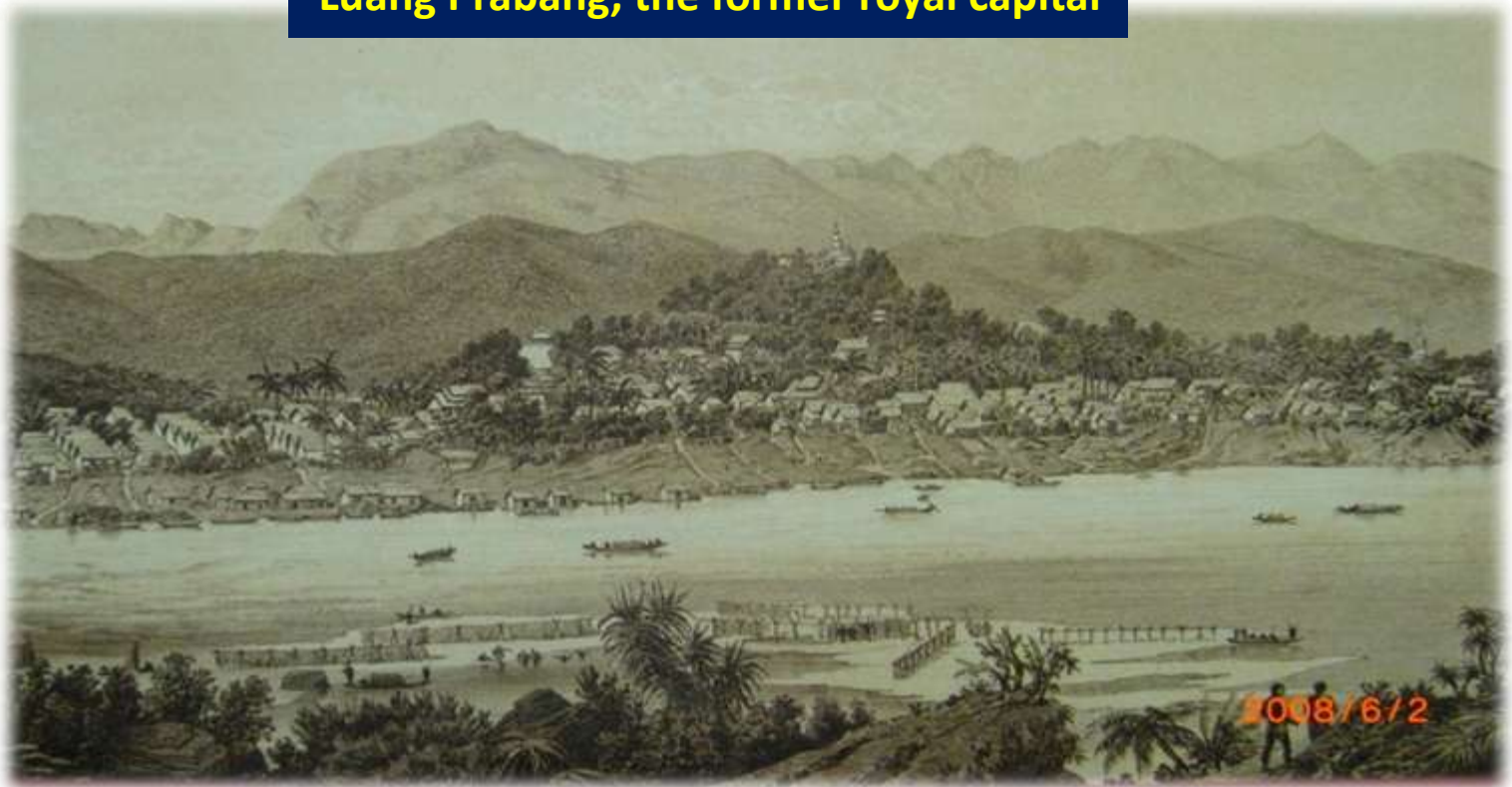

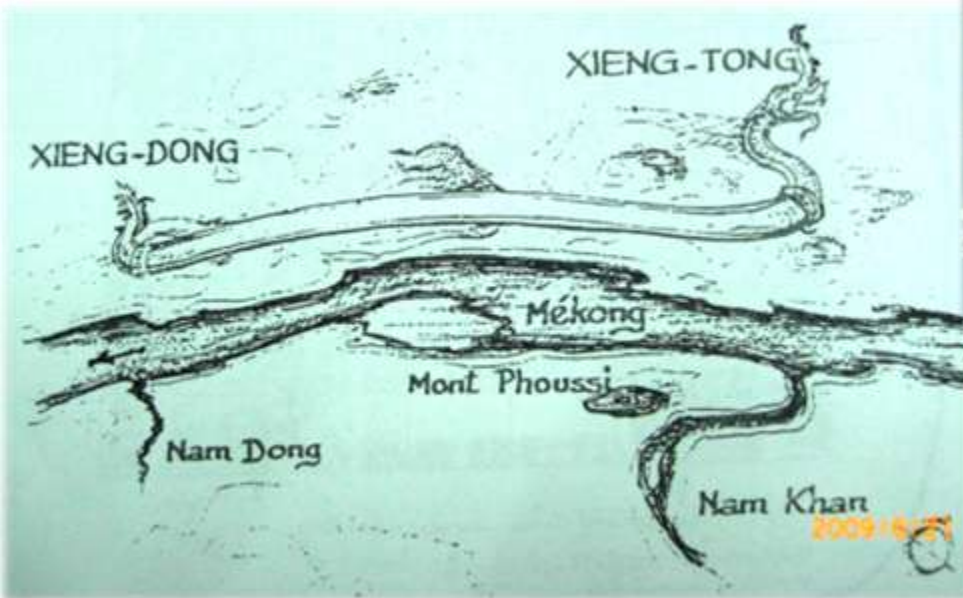
Map 1. Map of Luang Prabang

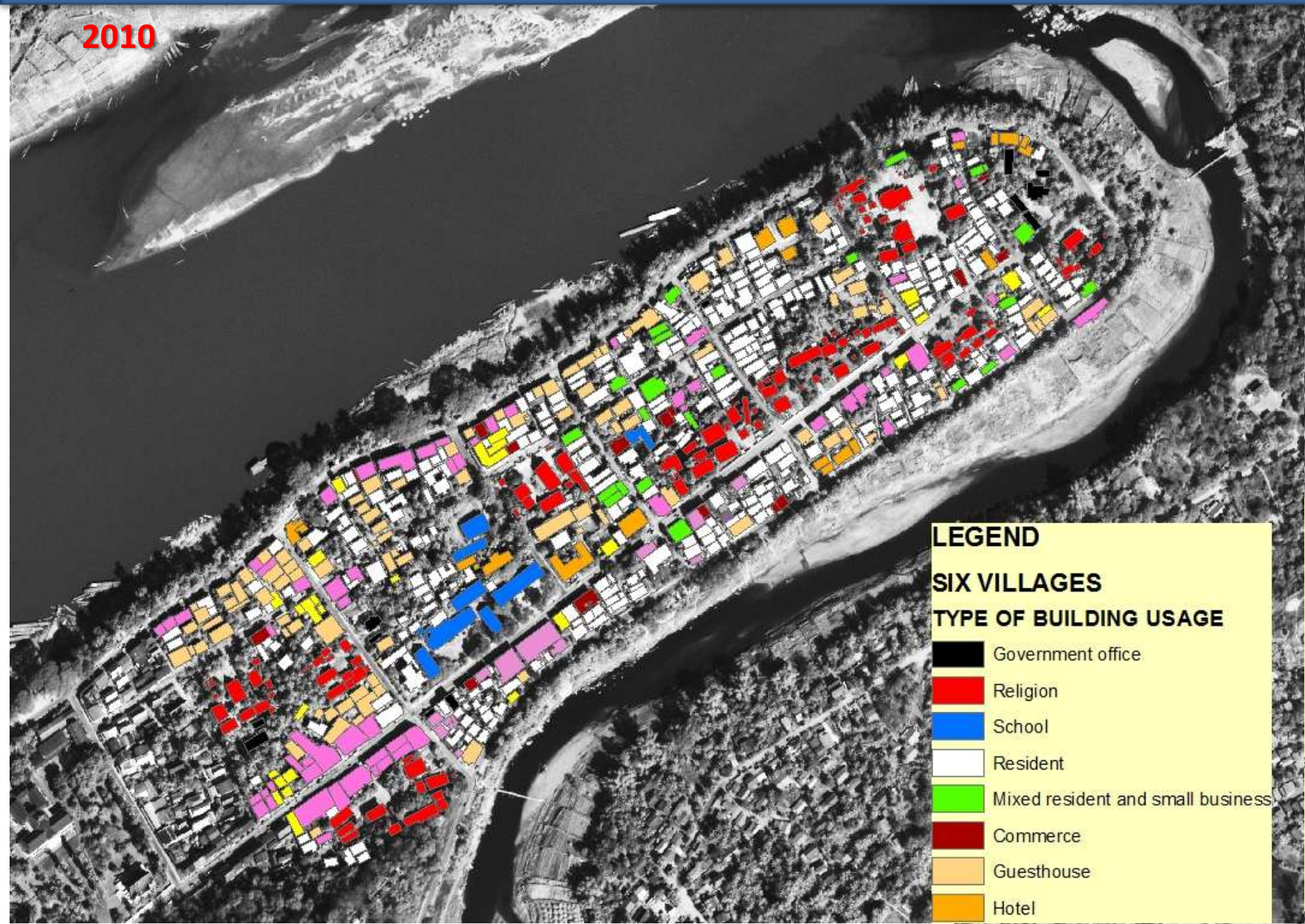
