Social Systems Modeling

Procedure for submitting three reports and for preparing for a poster presentation

1. Forming groups:

Form a group of 2 or 3 students by communicating with each other. Because each group needs to meet often for cooperative work, it is recommended that the group is constituted by members who are easy to arrange meetings (for example, the students from the same department).

2. Background Report:

By the fifth class (Thursday, October 31st), each group decides on the decision making situation to work on and submits a report on the background and the detail of the situation.

3. Model Report:

By the tenth class (Thursday, December 12th), each group submits a report on the model which is employed for the analysis of the selected decision making situation.

4. Analysis Report:

By the 15th class (Thursday, February 6th), each group submits a report on the results of the analysis of the decision making situation.

5. Presentation:

The 14th and 15th classes will be devoted to poster presentation by each group on the background, the model and the results of the analysis of the decision making situation. Each group has ten minutes for the presentation. After each presentation, we will have discussion for five minutes to achieve deeper understanding of the presentation.

All of the three reports and the presentation above will be evaluated with respect to the items on the evaluation sheets (which will be handed out during the first class). Refer to these items when writing the reports and preparing for the presentation.
