Abstract:

The lecturer worked in a Japanese electric power utility for ca.30 years, and then started working for a Japanese heavy industry which provides a half of products to foreign countries. The former is a monopolistic and domestic company selling only one product. The latter produces more than 700 different kinds of products and sells them to over-sea customers. By comparing them, it will be discussed in the lecture that different business styles request different abilities and attitudes for employees, and consequently lead to different company cultures.
