Exercises in Physics I and Physic Experiment I for GSEP Students Spring 2016 (1st and 2nd Quarters)

Exercises in Physics I (LAS. P105-09) and Physics Experiment I (LAS. P107-04) are both two-quarter courses designed to be accompanied with Fundamentals of Mechanics 1 (LAS. P101-09) & 2 (LAS. P102-09). The exercise sections are offered in small classrooms to help you develop problem-solving skills and deepen your understanding on physical theory covered in the lectures. In the experiment sections, students work in pairs to perform experiments and data analysis in the Introductory Physics Laboratory to confirm important concepts related to the course material. Students are strongly recommended to take both of them. However, it is not required and credits are given independently. Exercise sessions and experiment sessions take place in alternate weeks, at the same time and on the same day of the week so that you can fit both of them naturally into your class schedule.
