

Lecture Review

Yesterday, we reviewed your 18 May colloquium abstract submissions; fundamentally judging them on the basis of how they presented their topic to the audience. This was done by comparing each submission to published abstracts in various disciplines as well as to the other submitted abstracts. The reviewed process highlighted the importance of editing before submission. Special attention was given to the difference between English editing and editing for physics. In particular, we discussed the pros and cons of using an editing/translation service for English writing assistance.
