Public Law

Government and person (individual, entrepreneur) Ex. Constitution, Administrative Law, Criminal Law

Private Law

Person and Person Ex. Civil Code, Commercial Law

1.1.4 Function of Law

Social Governance Function

To secure people action subject to rules and sanctions.

Activity Promotion Function

To secure expectation of people to act

Dispute Resolution Function

To secure standard to solve dispute and maintaining the court system

Distribution Function

To secure economic activity, social welfare, resource distribution by tax
