2.1.1 The Absoluteness of ownership

The Constitution of Japan

Article 29

(1) "The right to own or to hold property is inviolable."

(2) "Property rights shall be defined by law, in conformity with the public welfare."

(3) "Private property may be taken for public use upon just compensation therefor."
